
CHOP CHOP BLOCK

2 - 10 inch squares - 1 light fabric and 1 dark fabric ***This will make an 11 ½ inch block. All seams ¼ inch.


STEP 1

With right sides together, begin sewing down 2 ½ inches from top right side edge. Backstitch at beginning. Pivot ¼ inch from bottom right corner and sew to the bottom left edge, ending with a backstitch.




STEP 2

Rotate block and sew the last two sides in the same way.



STEP 3


Cut the block diagonally through the sewn corners.



STEP 4


Place the triangles on top of one another carefully aligning all of the edges. Measure 2 ½ inches from the left edge and cut vertically through all layers.

STEP 5

Without disturbing the triangles, measure 2 % inches from the bottom edge and cut horizontally through all layers.



STEP 6

Arrange the units to form the chop chop block. Sew. Press seams in opposite directions so they will "nest" together. Trim block to $11 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.
